Project Description: This project a district, booster and community effort to fulfill the need of indoor softball hitting during the cold months. This facility was constructed on the Campbellsville Elementary School Campus adjacent to the High School Baseball, Softball and Track Athletic Facilities.



## Engineering Highlights:

N3D Group was hired by DS2 Architects to be the Project Managers, Mechanical, Electrical Engineers and Construction Administrators for the project. N3D Group oversaw construction provided by VanHook Enterprises, West Somerset, KY.

Project included a Girls Locker Room, Restroom, Coaches Office and a Hitting Area that is slated to receive artificial turf for the floor finishes. This facility was also constructed with no change orders!

HVAC System is point of use equipment. The Locker Rooms and Coaches Office is conditioned by PTAC Units and the Hitting Area is tempered with suspended unit gas heaters to keep the chill down on cold winter days.

The facility received a new electrical service with space for future expansions. The lighting is high efficient t-8 fluorescent fixtures with safety cages.

Project also included (2) sliding bay doors to allow room for extended hitting areas and natural ventilation on warmer days of practice.
